Tomorrow's Arrangements:

As a precaution, parents of students who are in year 3 to 6, please drop and collect at the gates. Years Prep to 2 may continue to drop at bollards or signs near doorways but must leave the grounds as soon as possible. If you are collecting from both junior and senior areas, please arrange a meeting point within the grounds and do not congregate at doorways, thank you.

Swimming Sports – years 4 to 6:

We have been advised by the Pines Forest Aquatic Centre that they are able to have us on site. However, any parents planning to attend must sign in at the QR Code at the entrance and wear masks while on-site in the venue. Please also ensure social distancing.

Curriculum Day:

Our Curriculum Day scheduled for Friday, 19th February will go ahead as planned. Many parents have arranged work schedules around this date so, now that we have the green light, changing would be problematic. Therefore, as the children have a student-free day, nothing on their Home Learning Grid is required.
