Dear Parents and Carers,

Update for Collection of Books and Devices/On-site Learning/Remote Learning.

As we move to remote learning again next week, please see information in relation to the collection of books and devices.

Books/resources: Teachers will have books that your child/ren will require ready for collection between 10.00 am and 3.00 pm on both Thursday 16th and Friday 17th July. You will be able to go straight to the classrooms and collect from the tables.

Devices: Unfortunately, will not be ready for collection until Friday. However, these will also be within your child classroom area. Following that they may be collected on Monday at the office.

Parents who are unable to come during these times due to work commitments etc, can contact us to make an alternative arrangement.

Please be mindful of social distancing, do not remain in the classrooms once you have collected items. Only two visitors to be in the rooms at any one time, including the office, thank you.

On-site learning: Students of essential workers or vulnerable students must complete the on-site attendance form so we are aware of the numbers that will require supervision. The form is attached.

Please note that:

Attendance is approved based on the assumption that the following statement is true and correct:

“Overport PS has a duty of care to provide a safe environment that is safe and without risks to health of student and staff.

As such, you are agreeing that your child/ren have not been exposed to the coronavirus or are experiencing symptoms such as fever, flu or cold-like symptoms or shortness of breath”.

It is recommended that you seek medical advice and they do not attend school if the above statement is incorrect.

Children are to meet at the hall between 8.45 am and 9.00 am. We are going to trial having the students with staff in groups in the hall to promote social connections. This will also allow sufficient staff to be able to move children to other areas for their relevant google meetings.

Remote Learning Attendance: It is expected that your child will engage each day with their related class goggle meets and undertake at least the minimum of work provided by their class teacher and the specialists. If your child is unwell, please email their teacher and the office on the day. We strong encourage you to ensure they have some physical activity each day.
