Dear Parents and Carers

The Victorian Government has announced further easing of restrictions under COVIDSafe Settings, effective from 11.59pm Thursday 24 June 2021.

On the advice of the Victorian Chief Health Officer, the easing of restrictions in regional Victoria and metropolitan Melbourne will remain in place for at least two weeks.

Key changes in the easing of restrictions that impact us include:

Density limits:

- In metropolitan Melbourne, a density limit of 1 person per 4 square metres still applies to these areas.
- Importantly, over the school holiday period there has been no change to the face mask advice, which will continue to apply to all Outside School Hours Care holiday programs.

At school:

- Children under 12 years of age and students at primary school are **not** required to wear face masks when at school, or when attending an OSHC program.
- For the purpose of communication, teachers and education support staff are not required to wear face masks while teaching, but those who wish to do so, can.
- Parents and carers, who are visiting as classroom helpers or for a meeting on school premises, can enter school grounds, however they must adhere to density limits and check in using the QR code.
- Visitors and parents must also observe face mask requirements.
- For drop off or collection of students after school, providing you are not on school premises for more than 15 minutes does not require you to check in through the QR code.
- Please continue to drop off or collect years 3 to 6 at the gate, and Prep to 2 may still be dropped and collected near the classroom area. Please observe social distancing.
