School returns to onsite schooling full time!

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are all looking forward to all the students, Prep to year 6, returning next Monday, 1st November. The return of all our students to full-time onsite learning is great news for all of us.

I would like to take this time to thank our community for the wonderful support that you have provided for the teachers and for your own children throughout these lockdowns. We understand that it has not always been easy! This has certainly been a huge team effort – parents and staff together.

Today is World Teachers Day. I encourage you to reach out with a warm message to your child's teacher or our specialist teachers, maybe outlining your appreciation for their hard work. This only comes when there is a love of teaching and desire to help young people to develop and become the very best they can be.

From Monday 1 November, face masks indoors will remain a requirement for students years 3 to 6 when in the classroom, unless they have an exemption. We do understand that a small number of students have exemptions for medical reason. In these cases, parents are required to send a signed notice explaining the reasons to the school.
