Dear Families,

Welcome back to Term 2! We have a very busy term ahead of us, and are looking forward to a more settled term.

Trees:

Over the holidays, we had some work done to remove trees that posed a danger within the school grounds. While we are saddened to lose these beautiful trees, we will be planting new trees as soon as possible. We are ensuring that all new trees planted will be suitable for our fire safety, and child safety standards so that they may grow well into the future. If any of our school community have ideas they would like to put forward, we would like to hear from you, as this school belongs to all of us.

Excursion:

Tomorrow, Wednesday the 21st of April, we will be attending the Da Vinci exhibit and learning experience at the Latrobe Regional Gallery. We will also be providing hot chips and primas for a special lunch before the exhibit. If your child does not like chips, or would like to bring lunch with them, this is encouraged. Please note that there is no supervision available at school during this excursion.

School Wide Positive Behaviours:

Last term, our closure day was used to confirm the direction of our SWPB framework. We are focusing on encouraging positive behaviour, respect, safety and high level learning effort through the use of positive reinforcements as much as possible. A common misconception of the program is that undesired behaviours are let go. Instead, the SWPB framework aims to correct these behaviours through teaching "workshops". These workshops are not a detention, or a punishment. Workshops are designed to address behaviours though replacing them with more positive choices.

The framework also comes with a lot of rewards and praise for positive behaviours. These rewards are not bribes, but are more like incentives for engaging with the "work". A way that we could use to look at this through adult lenses is everyday behaviour will receive regular earnings, working above expectations will have the potential for bonuses, and behaviour that requires additional work will be workshopped until change is made. As with all "work", there are extreme clauses and consequences for extreme behaviours, as per our behaviour policies.

Camp Information for 3/4 Camp:

Parents and Carers are encouraged to come to an informal information session at 9:00am this Friday in the staffroom to discuss any questions prior to our Week 2 camp. Camp can be a time of great excitement, but excitement often comes with nerves about the unknown. It is best to voice your feelings and ask any questions so that you feel secure with your children attending their first camp away from their families.
