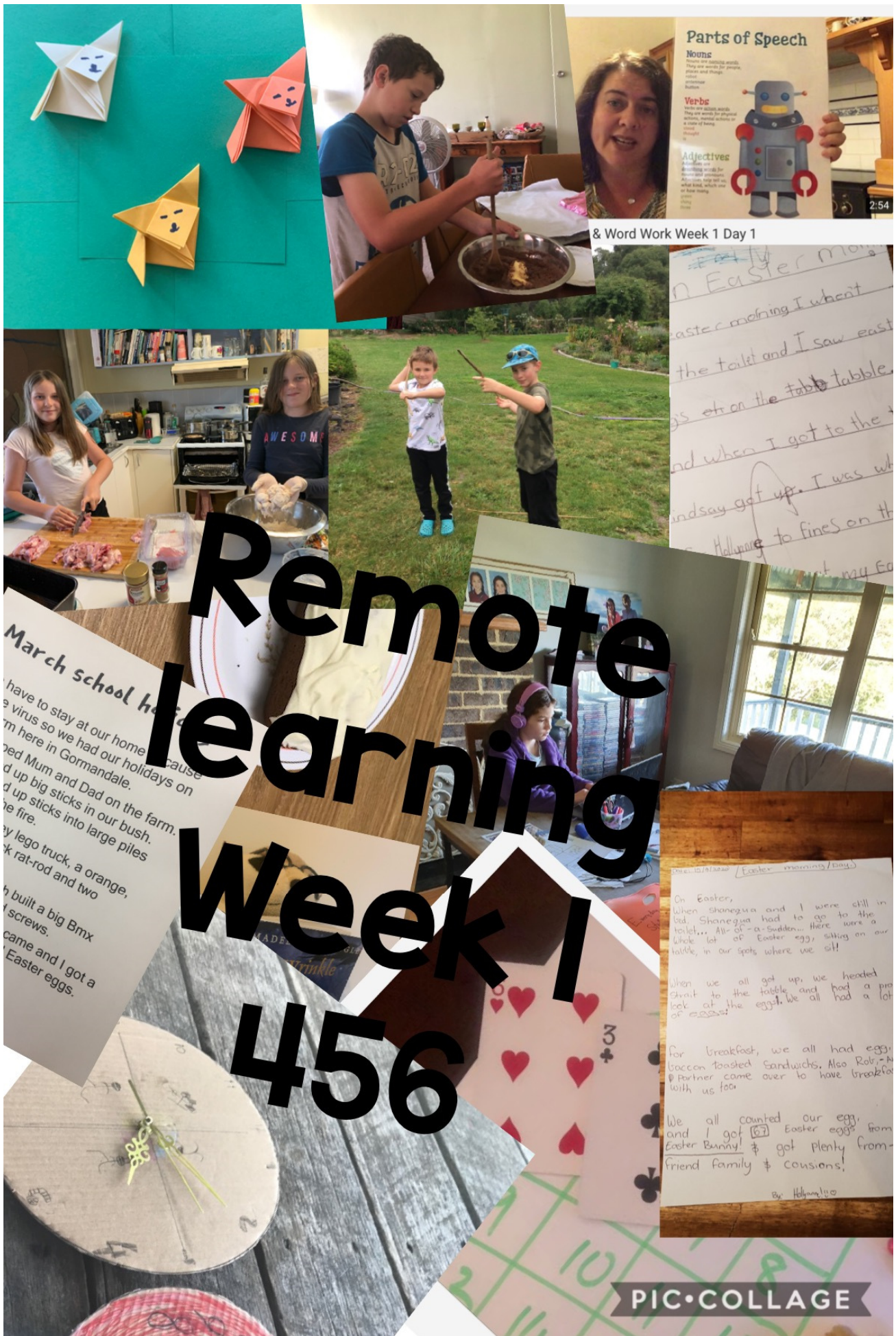
Hard copy packs will be available **9-12 Monday**. Please continue to follow distancing rules as outlined in last week's newsletter.

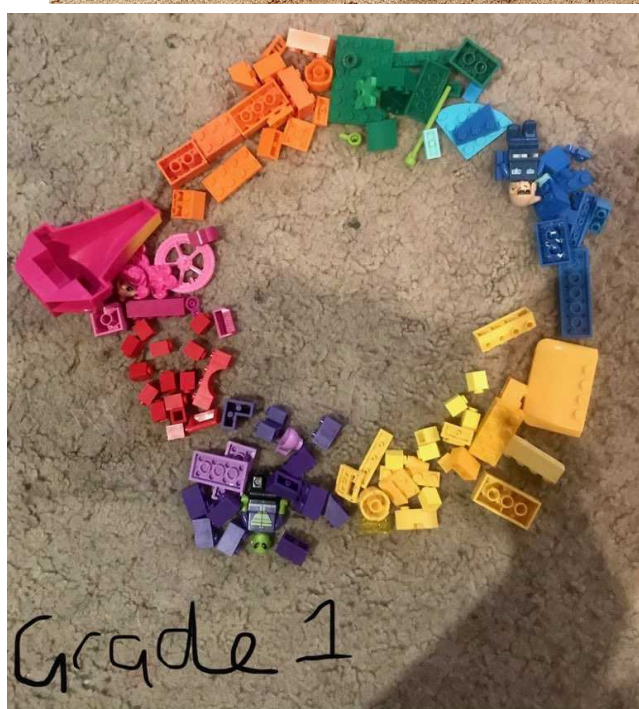
March school holidays
