Tomorrow we have our special Book Week dress up and activity day. The whole school will participate in a range of literacy based activities that are centred around this year's Children's Book Council of Australia's shortlisted books. This week we have been talking about the concept of "Challenge". Often children feel disheartened if learning is not "easy", or if they have to work at it. We have been discussing the idea that "Easy is boring, Challenge is interesting", using the picture below. The idea being that the easy road will get you there, but there is nothing interesting along the way, and it is a very boring road to choose. The challenging road presents obstacles, and may require effort or teamwork to navigate, however it will be much more interesting and satisfying to travel this road.

A person travelling a challenging road may fall down, get stuck, or need help to get through it. They would very rarely fall down in the middle, give up, and stay stuck there forever! Learning works in the same way. A learner taking on a challenge may fall down, get stuck, and need help – this is what school is for! A child who falls on a path outside would not hesitate in accepting help or trying again, it is important for us to take the same approach with learning path!

This week's challenge is to design a poster around the idea "Easy is boring, Challenge is interesting" using a similar idea to our picture here. A4 size paper is available from school if you would like to join in. The winning design will be copied and laminated for display in the school and on the front sign!


