Given the Chance Jobs Victoria Employment Program is an employment service for long-term jobseekers living in the Metro Northern, **Metro South Eastern** and Metro West areas of Melbourne and is delivered by the Brotherhood of St Laurence.

This service is offered to a broad group of jobseekers including;

- *Long term unemployed more than 6 months*
- *People from a refugee background*
- *People seeking asylum*
- *People who are Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander*
- *Mature age people (aged 50+)*
- *Retrenched workers*
- *Young people 15-24 (disengaged and not engaged in education, training or employment)*
- *Youth justice clients*
- *Single parents*
- *People with a disability*
- *Social housing tenants*
- *Ex-offenders*
- *Veterans and/or veterans families*
- *People experiencing homelessness*
- *Low income (under employed)*

Given the Chance Jobs Victoria Employment Program is funded by the Victorian State Government through Jobs Victoria.

This program utilises an innovative recruitment model, working intensively with employers and jobseekers. We use an



early intervention, intensive support model. Jobseekers receive one to one assistance to create an employment pathway with a focus on developing new skills and renewing confidence.
