Dear Families,

Welcome to Week 2 of Term 3!

This week we are delighted to welcome new members of staff to our team! We welcome Keely Longmore and Hannah Robbins to Gormandale & District Primary School in Education Support roles. Keely and Hannah will be providing support in all classrooms, we will also have Tricia providing additional support for the next few weeks. We know that this will be a welcome addition to all classes, and look forward to working together!

It is wonderful to be back at school, and we hope that on site school will continue for us for the rest of the term. For any families with questions about this, the answer is; the schools all find out information via public press conferences along with the rest of the public. The guidelines for schools are updated as necessary, and we continue to follow guidelines as best we can.

Some measures that the school have in place are:

- Children from P-3 use soap and water to wash their hands when returning from the yard
- Children from 4-6 use a hand sanitizer station when entering the classroom
- Each room has a hand sanitizer station for use by all entering
- Adults have restricted access to the school unless staff (school council and parents with urgent reason and prior notice)
- Pie warmer is currently not being used in an attempt to limit any possible cross contamination through food from different households
- All staff or students with any symptoms of illness are asked to stay home
- Any COVID-19 symptoms of illness must be tested with a negative outcome before returning to school
- Any siblings of students that have signs of illness are also asked to stay home and seek medical advice

We thank our school community for your continued support with these, and any future measures. It is important to remember that it only takes one case to spread quickly throughout a community. It is impossible to know who we have been in contact with when out in public, and where they have been. Due to this, it is highly important that we do not become complacent in our rural setting, and continue to act with a high level of caution.

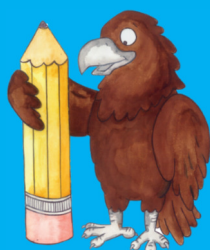

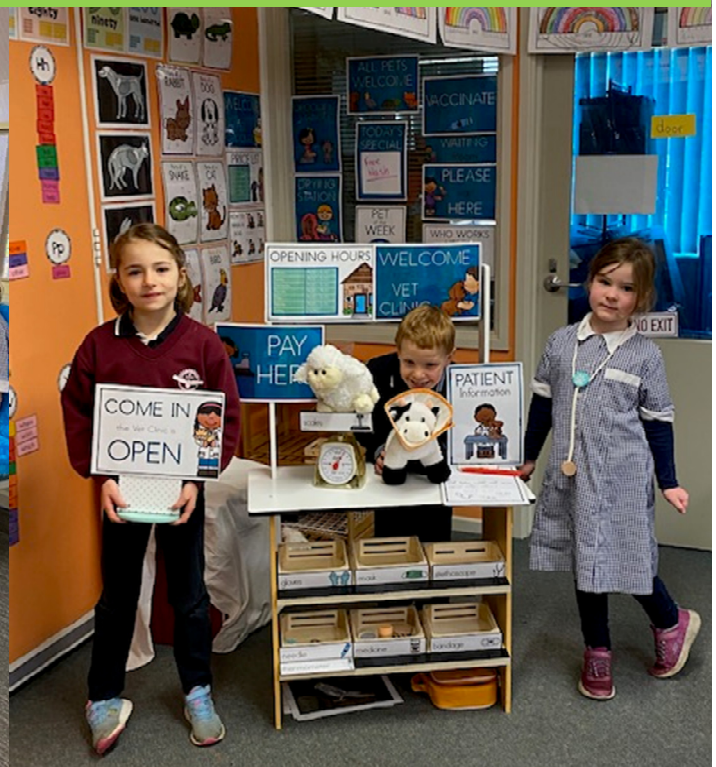
