CSEF (Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund) 2023

If you applied for CSEF at Overport Primary School last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

New applicants should access the form from the school's website.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- · new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools this year.
- · changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

To be eligible for the fund, a parent or carer of a student attending a registered Government or non-government Victorian primary must, **on the first day of Term one 30**th January 2023, be a holder of one or more of the eligible financially-means tested cards OR be a temporary foster parent.
