Congratulations to all parents for your wonderful uptake of our new Compass App. Excursion permission and payments have been completed incredibly quickly and successfully by our school community. We have noticed how much easier it is for parents to be aware of upcoming events and it has eliminated the need for paper permission notes - great for our environment!

Did you know you can also record your child/ren's absences on Compass as well? This is a great time saver and no longer requires you to send in notes, phone the school or send an email. Just follow these easy steps:

1. Go to profile
2. Blue bar at the bottom "Add attendance note"
3. Select child who will be away
4. The reason defaults to Medical/illness but you can change this if necessary
5. **And save!**

Swimming Program –years 1 to 3

Children in prep have been looking at fairy tales and created a picture of a bear using paint and sponges.

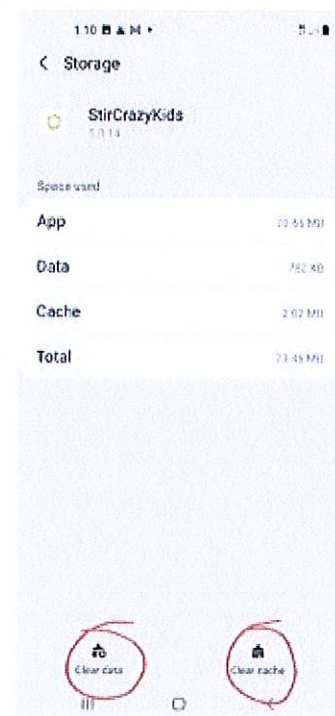
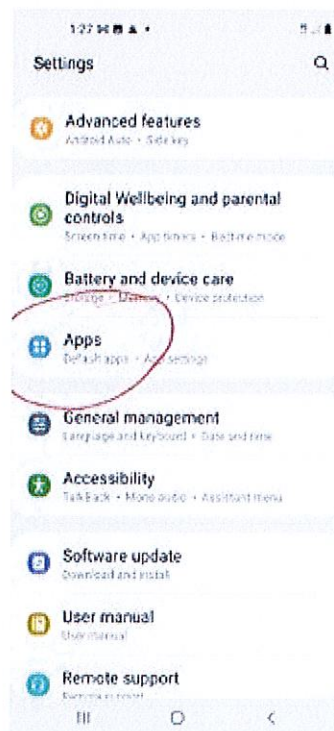

Android Phone App Reset.

These instructions have helped many Android phone users to reset the Stir Crazy Kids App on their Phone.



If you have the green spinning circle and cannot login past it, go to your phone settings. Scroll down to Apps. Tap on Apps and scroll to the Stir Crazy Kids App. Tap on the App, then Storage and you will see the clear cache and clear data at the bottom of the page. Clear the cache and delete the data

It won't delete your information off the App.

Swipe out and you should be able to login into the App.
