Health Impacts of Vaping

Risks for Young people and Youths.

Vaping is unsafe and potentially dangerous. While the long-term health effects are unclear, we do know that vaping in the short-term has been associated with nausea, vomiting, mouth and airway irritation, chest pain and heart palpitations and in some cases, even death. It is critical that you become well aware of the dangers and that you discuss these with your children.

What are the actual risks of vaping?

Besides nicotine, e-cigarettes contain harmful and potentially harmful ingredients, such as:

- ultrafine particles that can be inhaled deep into the lungs.
- flavorists such as diacetyl, a chemical linked to serious lung disease.
- volatile organic compounds.
- heavy metals, such as nickel, tin, and lead.

They are designed to be addictive and are readily available without regulatory control; such as on some milk bar counters near sweets. Some look like marker pens or other items that would attract young children. Some have smells, such as watermelon and other attractive flavorings. They are highly addictive and significantly dangerous. Research suggests that in some cases children as young as 8 years old have tried vaping. Further information can be found at:
