## **Update For Our Community**

As we now find ourselves at the end of this strange term heading for the term break I would like to wish you all a restful and safe holiday period. Again I thank our community for the restful approach to the return to school and the support you have given your child/ren during the remote learning and the many appreciative emails, cards and FB comments thanking the staff at OPS.

Some information for you:

- 1. Tomorrow we finish at 2.30 pm. Students may be collected from 2.15 pm.
- 2. Next term begins on 13th July and doors will open at 8.45 am. Students are expected to be here by 9.00 am. Please say farewell at the gate and avoid coming into the grounds if at all possible.
- **3.** Reports will go home next term in week 3 with a general comment and curriculum overviews.
- **4.** School photos have been rescheduled in term 4 on 29th & 30th October.
- **5.** Our Curriculum Day for the *Real Schools* program has been rescheduled to 21st August. Our last Curriculum Day which will cover Effective Writing Assessment Procedures, has now been approved for 9th October. Extend will offer OHSC on these days should you require care.
- **6.** Our Prep to 2 concert has been cancelled. We are considering alternative arrangements that we can undertake, at least for our Preps, this year. Also if you have a sibling please contact the office for an enrolment application and return to the school as soon as possible at the beginning of next term.

## 'Triple P' (Positive Parenting Program).

Access to the online Positive Parenting Program is now available online for free to all Victorian families by accessing free expert parenting advice through the online Triple P – Positive Parenting Program.

The program is relevant to families with children between 2 and 16 years and provides strategies to deal with specific challenges, such as building children's resilience and dealing with conflict.

There are courses specifically for parents of toddlers to tweens, and for parents of pre-teens to teens.

It gives parents strategies to:

- raise happy, confident kids
- manage misbehaviour so everyone in the family enjoys life more
- set rules and routines that everyone respects and follows
- encourage positive behaviour
- take care of themselves as a parent
