**Plans for our second week of lock down to support
our Remote and Flexible Learning.**

Dear Parent and Carers,

Whilst the information shared yesterday from our Acting Premier was not what we were hoping for, we are well prepared and know that the strength and unity of our school community will support us all as we progress through this time.

Following the announcement, as I am sure you are aware, we head into an extension of this current lockdown for a further 7 days concluding on Thursday 10th June.

As we are now transitioning to the next step of our plan, based on the length of each lockdown, over the next coming days you can expect the following from our Remote and Flexible Learning approach:

- Tomorrow a wellbeing 'Google Meet' will take place. Details will be sent from your child/ren's class teacher. (Also, I will be sharing a story online for our Wellbeing Day as I did last year during this time, and I will send through the link- please join me!)
- As of next week, there will be three 'Google Meets' at various times to minimise possible clashes.
- Each of these will commence with a short wellbeing focus, followed by relevant information or teaching specific to either a writing, reading or mathematics task.
- These will support your child to complete their on-line or Learning Grid tasks. Teachers will also upload lessons on SeeSaw for the years Prep to 4 and Google Classroom for years 5 & 6.
- We are providing off-line and on-line options. However, if you have **no** access to a device, we are in the process of having a number available for you to borrow by tomorrow afternoon. Please contact me directly with your needs.

We have responded to feedback from our students and the community to ensure we offer the best option for everyone. As with any programming in our school, we will continue to make improvements and adjustments to ensure the children's needs are being addressed.

I sincerely hope that all children can return on-site as soon as possible, and our regular school-based program can resume.
