Using the book that you are reading, Draw a picture of what you think your main character looks like - Use detail.	What is a big change in the world you would like to make?	Many words are overused in writing. Some of these include: <i>happy, big, went, great, like</i> . In a table, list at least 5 more interesting synonyms for each of these words.	Choose and list the price of 10 supermarket items. Round each price to the nearest dollar. Use the rounded price to calculate the total cost of the items.	Voting in elections in Australia is compulsory. Do you agree or disagree with compulsory voting? List and explain at least 3 reasons to support your viewpoint.	Write down 3 people that you are grateful for and why.
Read a story to an adult and then ask them questions about it.	What is your favourite natural element: earth, air, fire or water? Why?	Brainstorm 10 -15 words which contain the /f/ as in fish. Calculate the value of each of your words. -Vowels are worth 7 points -Consonants are worth 4 points Example: Recess 4X7X4X7X4X4= 12,544	Imagine you are having a party. You have \$100 to spend. Create a simple budget for the party, listing the items you will buy with their amounts.	Create an informative poster explaining all the ways that the sun provides energy for planet Earth.	What mistake have you made that has helped you learn? Draw a picture.
Read the beginning of a story and then invent your own ending.	Create a picture book for your buddy.	Brainstorm 10 -15 words containing the /f/ as in fish sound. Create an acrostic poem for each of these words.	Create a timetable for all the important events in your day using 24 -hour time. Write 5 word problems to accompany your timetable.	You have landed on the imaginary planet 'Yuck'. Compare the lifestyle there with planet Earth. Draw a picture of planet 'Yuck' and of the Earth for the comparison.	Do something kind for someone in your life. Eg. Do the dishes, cook dinner, make them a card.
Create a sequel to your favourite story.	Write your teacher a letter about what you are doing at home at the moment.	Brainstorm 10 - 15 words containing the /f/ as in fish sound. Write each word in the shape of a pyramid, adding a letter in each line .	Observe and record the type and number of cars that drive past your home during a half hour period.	Design your own space suit, labelling materials and features and why they are necessary for survival.	Who is someone in your family that you are thankful for - Write them a card expressing why you feel that way.
Read a book and then create a new front cover for it.	Write a recipe for a new food item and create it with your family.	Find a picture or photograph. Write a caption for the photograph using as many /f/ as in fish words as possible.	Play the card game 'snap'. Every time you 'snap', you need to multiply the number on the card by a focus times table. E.g. This week if you're practising x5, if you've snapped a pair of 3s, you need to do 2 x 3.	The planets are ordered as follows: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune,(Pluto). Create a mnemonic device to help you remember their order and draw each planet underneath.
